

GRADING SYSTEM AT THE INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF MONACO

Modules and Credits - The content of the programs at IUM is delivered in modules that include different academic subjects. Modules carry academic credits on the basis of 1 credit per 15 contact hours or equivalent.

Grades - The final grade of a module is the weighted average of the final grades of its component subjects with their respective weights. Grades are given in percentage form. To pass a module and obtain the corresponding credits, a student needs to achieve a final grade of 60 or better for the module and a final grade of at least 45 in each academic subject. The Academic Jury reserves the right to grant module credits on exceptional grounds on a case-by-case basis.

Percentage grade ranges correspond to letter grades as illustrated in the Grading Scale table below :
